Tres igitur tribuni tripertito ad devastandos Volscorum fines discesserunt. Valerius atque Cornelius late populati sunt tecta agrosque, ut distinerent Volscos; Fabius ad Anxur oppugnandum sine ulla populatione accessit. quattuor cohortes circummissae cum imminentem urbi collem cepissent, moenia, ubi nullum erat praesidium, ingenti clamore ac tumultu ex loco altiore invaserunt. hoc tumultu obstupefacti sunt ei qui adversus Fabium urbem infimam tuebantur, locumque dederunt ad scalas admovendas. plena hostium cuncta erant, et atrox diu caedes fugientium ac resistantium, armatorum atque inermium, fuit. oppidanorum duo milia et quingenti vivi capti sunt: Fabius a cetera praeda milites abstinuit, donec collegarum exercitus venirent; dictabat enim ab illis quoque captum Anxur esse, quia Volscos a praesidio eius loci avertissent: qui ubi venerunt, oppidum vetus atque opulentum tres exercitus diripuerunt.
