- x 3. Give an account of the events leading up to St Peter's visit to Cornelius, and explain the significance of his vision at Joppa.
- x 4. Summarize briefly what we learn from these chapters of St Paul's career up to the time of his commissioning at Antioch for the first missionary journey?
- x 5. What was the question at issue at the Council of Jerusalem, what arguments were put forward about it by the Apostles, and how was it settled?
- 6. What information can be gathered from these chapters about the development of the Christian ministry?
- x 7. Write notes on **five** of the following passages:
  - (a) Lord, dost thou at this time restore the kingdom to Israel?
  - (b) Peter said, Repent ye, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ unto the remission of your sins; and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.
